May is "California Museums Month!"

I just learned about this a few weeks ago. Too bad, but I don't think it's to late to be getting the word out. For over ten years, the California Association of Museum's (CAM) has celebrated May as California Museums Month and the essential role museum's play in the lives of Californians. Over three dozen California museums and hundreds of individuals have promoted the Snoopy license plate this past month and helped us collect over 3,300 orders so far. We only have 4,200 more to go to create a new funding stream for museums with revenue generated by an official California Snoopy license plate. (www.snoopyplate.com).



How will this program benefit museums? The proceeds generated from the sales of Snoopy special interest license plates will go into a designated fund to be administered by the State agency sponsor, the California Cultural and Historical Endowment (CCHE). This fund will be used to support a new grant program to benefit California museums - from art and history museums to science centers, natural history museums, zoos, and aquariums. 

Trivia Answer 1: After many years of futile experiments, that pushed his family into near poverty, Charles Goodyear invented what is now called the "Vulcanization" process. The discovery's basis came in the Winter of 1839.

Trivia Answer 2: Woohaa! Trick question! Charles Goodyear did NOT found the company that bears his name. The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company was founded in 1898, 38 years after Charles Goodyear died! It was founded by Frank Seiberling, and named "Goodyear" in Charles Goodyear's honor. Way to go Frank!

Here's a bit of Goodyear history: Charles Goodyear died July 1, 1860, while traveling to see his dying daughter. After arriving in New York, he was informed that she had already died. He collapsed and was taken to the Fifth Avenue Hotel in New York City, where he died at the age of 59. He is buried in New Haven at <u>Grove Street Cemetery</u>.

On February 8, 1976, he was among six individuals selected for induction into the <u>National Inventors</u> Hall of Fame.

In <u>Woburn, Massachusetts</u>, there is an elementary school named after him. The Government of France made him a Chevalier de la Légion d'honneur in 1855.

The ACS Rubber Division awards a medal named in Goodyear's honor, the <u>Charles Goodyear Medal</u>. The medal honors principal inventors, innovators, and developers whose contributions resulted in a significant change to the nature of the rubber industry.

<u>The Goodyear Welt</u>, a technique in handmade shoemaking that significantly increases the lifespan of a shoe used by <u>Wildsmith</u>, one of the oldest English shoemakers and other traditional manufacturers was named after and in honor of its inventor, Charles' son; Charles Goodyear Jr.
