So let's move on to the shows now. Pickin's are very slim, I know more are out there, and I hope you get a chance to attend them.





- The vehicle is the Bevo Boat. It was manufactured to promote Bevo Ginger Ale by none other than Anheuser Busch. Like many other breweries, they stayed alive during prohibition by brewing soft drinks, Bevo Ginger Ale being one of them. The company appears to have started out building it's own rolling stock and delivery equipment in the late 1800's. In addition to building these promotional cars in later years, they produced both refrigerated and standard truck bodies, a camping car, a depot hack, and bodies for horse transport and buses, some of which can be *viewed here*.
