Trivia Answers:

- 1. Credit for inventing seat belts goes back to the early 19th century, to an English engineer, George Cayley.
- 2. However, Edward J. Claghorn of New York, was granted the first patent on February 10, 1885 for a safety belt. Claghorn was granted United States Patent #312,085 for a Safety-Belt for tourists, painters, firemen, etc. who are being raised or lowered, described in the patent as "designed to be applied to the person, and provided with hooks and other attachments for securing the person to a fixed object."
- 3. American car manufacturers Nash (in 1949) and Ford (in 1955) offered seat belts as options, while Swedish Saab first introduced seat belts as standard in 1958. After the Saab GT 750 was introduced at the New York Motor Show in 1958 with safety belts fitted as standard, the practice became more commonplace.
- 4. In 1911, Benjamin Foulois had the cavalry saddle shop fashion a belt for the seat of Wright Flyer Signal Corps 1. He wanted it to hold him firmly in his seat so he could better control his aircraft as he bounded along the rough field used for takeoff and landing. It was not until WWII that seat belts were fully adopted in military aircraft. However, it is believed that it was done mainly for safety reasons, not improved aircraft control.
