

We all know him from such creations as the Munster Koach and the Batmobile, along with many other creations. He was most famous for the Batmobile, a retooled version of a 1955 Lincoln Futura concept car that allegedly cost the Ford Motor Company \$250,000.00. When Ford was unable to make use of it, Barris picked it up for one dollar! In the '60s TV show "Batman," the Batmobile was powered by atomic batteries, equipped with a radar scope, a "bat beam," and slowed by parachutes. The parachutes really worked! Barris was once pulled over on the Hollywood Freeway for using them. Barris was 89.
