

#### Show Classes

To ensure that trophies for this show are awarded in the fairest way possible, independent judges (not from the host club) are assigned to review and score entries in each class. Please review the classes shown below and select the best one for your car. Contact Sam Fisher (contact information on Page 3) if you have any questions about your car and how it may fit into a class.

#### Stock Classes

Vehicle may not have any modifications listed under the definition of the Modified classes. Vehicle should have a stock appearance. No more than 3 of the following changes will be allowed in the stock class: Non-stock appearing intake/carburetor, exhaust manifolds, headers, wheels/tires (within appropriate size range and style to be age appropriate and to be consistent with a stock appearance), ignition, radiator, AC c ompressor, auxiliary gauges, battery cables and other items considered as minor. If more than three changes are detected during judging, the score for the vehicle may be adjusted. In addition to these items, paint will not have to necessarily match an OEM color but should be done in a manner that does not distract from the stock appearance. If two or more vehicles are considered tied during judging, the most stock appearing vehicle will prevail. Vehicles entered in Class Q (Unrestored/Survivor) may not have more than one exterior panel re-painted; one seat cushion replaced, minor engine work, etc.

B: 66-67 GTO, 442, GS hardtop and convertible

C: 68-74 GTO, 442, GS hardtop and convertible

D: 67-69 Firebird/Trans Am hardtop and convertible

E: 70-81 Firebird/Trans Am hardtop and convertible

F: 82-02 Firebird/Trans Am hardtop and convertible

G: All LeMans, Cutlass, Skylark hardtop and convertible

H: All Full Size Convertibles

I: 48 and Prior Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Buick, Cadillac and Oakland

J: 49-58 Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Buick and Cadillac

K: 59-72 Pontiac, Oldsmobiile, Buick and Cadillac

L:73 to Current Stock Pontiac, Oldsmobiile, Buick and Cadillac

M: All Fiero and Reatta

N: 04-06 GTO, G8 and Solstice

O: All GMC Trucks (Stock and Modified)

P: All Grand Prix, Toronado, Riviera, El Dorado and Starfire

Q: All Unrestored/Survivor 1977 and older

The Pontiacs of Central California Chief Judge reserves the right to make the final determination whether a car is to be entered in Stock, Street Stock or Modified class and to make class changes without notice. Those decisions shall be regarded as final.

#### Street Stock Classes:

Vehicles may not have any modifications listed under the definition of Modified Classes. Vehicle must have a stock appearance but minor changes exceed those in definition of Stock.

R: to 58 Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Buick and Cadillac

S: 59-72 Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Buick and Cadillac

T: 73 to Current Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Buick and Cadillac

**Display Only (Not Judged)** - Any vehicle "under construction" or for show only

#### **Modified Classes:**

Altered or non-original engine that is either high performance or bored/stroked to an increase of over 50 cubic inches, major body or interior modifications, chromed or de-chromed 30% or more, major changes in riding height, custom paint or interior, non-original hood scoop or hood, vehicle set up for racing or with hydraulics.

U: to 58 Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Buick and Cadillac

V: 59-72 Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Buick and Cadillac

W: 73 to Current Pontiac, Oldsmobile, Buick and Cadillac

X: Special Interest
